Fire Chief's Report – see new business

New Business:

New Engine and Grass Truck - Chief Riggs reported the build time for a new fire engine is 2 ½ to 3 years from the date of order with a price around \$750,000.00. The board directed Chief Riggs to develop a spec sheet for the new engine. The replacement of the 2002 Grass Truck is on hold for now.

Day Time Staffing - Chief Riggs also reported that firefighter's available for daytime calls is limited. He also stated that the Bellevue Community Fire Department has begun having a paid firefighter staff their station during the daytime hours 8am to 5pm. Asst. Chief Harvey said the position is paid, but it is not a full-time paid position, it is staffed by firefighters who sign up for an available shift. Chief Riggs feels with the potential growth in the township this is something the Township should look into. Chief Riggs and Asst. Chief Harvey will have further discussions with Chief Jackson as how the program is working for Bellevue and how a similar model may work for the Township.

Vice Chairman Lyng addressed the board about looking into the billing of fire runs. After a discussion, the board directed Chief Riggs to report back at the next fire board meeting with some ideas and companies for billing of fire runs.
