Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,5000 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a government subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA2230, CL125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

VI. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

ITEM #1, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE:

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites.

When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a remanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

VII. INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING APPLICATIONS

GENERAL: Mechanical work shall not be started until the permit has been issued or other approval has been obtained. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The Inspector will need the Job Location & Permit Number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
