### IX. INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING APPLICATIONS

**GENERAL:** Mechanical work shall not be started until the permit has been issued or other approval has been obtained. All installations shall be in conformance with the state Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The Inspector will need the Job Location & Permit Number.

**EXPIRATION OF PERMIT:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.

**WHERE TO SUBMIT APPLICATION:** Permit applications for township issued permits should be sent to the address listed on the front of this application. If you are not sure whether township permit is appropriate, contact your local inspector. Code questions may be directed to your local inspector.
